For **Stefan Najda** (negotiator for the trade union ver.di), this is a clear negotiating success: »We had to keep chipping away. Ultimately, however, the creative activities of our unionists in the companies helped us in the negotiations. The employers were surprised by our determination. Only thus were we able to achieve this result, especially during the ongoing obligation to observe industrial peace (the current collective agreement runs up until 31 December 2024). This successful collective agreement sends the right message at the right time. All employees, trainees and dual students will now receive significantly more money over a period of 13 months. And, what's more, our union members will get an additional day off!«

**Saskia Kleber** (KJAV Chair and member of the negotiating commission) added: »Our trainees and dual students now not only have more money in their pockets. Thanks to the extension of the previous hiring regulations in the companies up to and including 2029, they can look to their professional future with confidence. In so doing, the employer is making it clear that it can only meet the challenges of the future with well trained and well paid skilled workers. And that's us. We're the future of energy!«



**Lothar Haberzeth** (Chairman of the ver.di federal specialist committee for the industry) thanked the entire collective bargaining commission and all ver.di employees on the ground as a member of the negotiating team: »This result didn't happen by itself. Our joint success is a great win for all employees, but it was only achieved thanks to the commitment and dedication of our ver.di members. We call on all employees who have yet to sign up to become a member of ver.di today! Only together will we be able to continue to celebrate further collective bargaining successes in the future!«
